Aon Risk Services Australia Ltd v ANU [2009] HCA 27: What does this mean for litigation and how will it affect trial preparation?

The High Court unanimously upheld the importance of proper case management to ensure a 'just, quick and cheap resolution of the real issues between the parties' to litigation. These objectives are now paramount considerations in the way that Courts deal with applications for amendment of pleadings and adjournments. It also impacts on the trial preparation process and how to meet the challenges of timely and efficient preparation for trial.
